## Contract for access to extended opening hours

### Welcome as a user of the Drammen public library's extended opening hours.

This contract gives you over the age of 15 access to the library from 7:00 to 23:00 every day throughout the year.

The library is a public and shared space, and is for the use and enjoyment of everyone in it.

By upgrading your library card to an access-card for the extended opening hours, you agree to follow these simple rules:

- Be considerate to other users
- Clean up after yourself
- Keep noise and behavior at a respectful level
- Follow the current lending rules and regulations

Everyone over the age of 15 must have their own, upgraded library card. Parents / guardians can bring children under 15 years. For the safety of the children, they should not be left alone for an extended period of time. The contract and the library card are personal and only you can use the card as an admission card. Violation of this condition may result in the suspension of the right to use the extended opening hours of Drammen public library.

There is video surveillance in the library room and recordings are stored safely in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. The surveillance is for your safety and for the protection of the library's inventory and equipment. All data is automatically deleted after seven days. Vandalism will be reported to the police. Staying at the extended opening hours-library is on your own responsibility.
